

ABOUT ST. PETER'S HEALTH FOUNDATION

Established in 1978, the Foundation encourages and manages all charitable contributions to St. Peter's Health—a not-for-profit, community based health system located in Helena. The only full-service, acute care facility in our region, St. Peter's provides general, specialty and emergency health care services to the estimated 97,000 residents of Lewis and Clark, Broadwater, Jefferson, Meagher and Powell Counties.

St. Peter's Health does not have shareholders to whom returns are distributed; all profits are devoted to supporting our mission. Each year, St. Peter's reinvests over \$14 million into the community through health education, courtesy ambulance services at sporting events or other large community gatherings, and free or reduced-cost health care to ensure that financial limitations do not prevent individuals from seeking or receiving care.

Contributions made to St. Peter's and the Foundation are primarily used to:

- ✓ Provide assistance to patients and families for medically-related costs not covered by insurance;
- ✓ Subsidize services - especially those critical to the elderly - such as Hospice, Lifeline and Cardiopulmonary Rehab;
- ✓ Expand and improve health care services for the broader community; or
- ✓ Purchase or construct state-of-the-art medical equipment, technology and facilities.

PATIENT ASSISTANCE THROUGH ST. PETER'S HEALTH FOUNDATION

One of the Foundation's recurring funding priorities - and the purpose of our annual golf tournament - is to provide assistance to St. Peter's patients for one-time or temporary medically-related expenses not covered by insurance. This can include things like wigs for chemo patients, nutritional supplements, discharge medications, and travel expenses.

One example of these funds being put to good use is the story of Letty Hoffman. In February 2017, Letty found her life at a stopping point. A serious reaction to medication had caused complete kidney failure, forcing the then 20-year-old Helena native to start dialysis. The daily treatments meant plans for getting a job or going to college were on hold. Worst was the toll it took on her family.

Thanks to patient assistance funds made possible through the generosity of donors, the Foundation was able to help Letty and her family with travel expenses so she could fly to Salt Lake City for a transplant in August 2018.

Letty has seen firsthand how donations to St. Peter's Health Foundation can help change lives. Now she wants to spend her life giving back after all that people gave to her.

The transplant was a success and allowed her to return to doing what she loves and planning for her future. She's now working as a phlebotomist at St. Peter's Health and considering pursuing a career in nursing.
